## **NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** Rule 6C1-5.001 is being repealed as being duplicative of existing Florida law. Rule 6C1-5.071 is being repealed. Revised information from this rule shall be included in University of Florida Statement of Organization and Operation. Rule 6C1-5.0761 is being amended to revise the definitional language required by accrediting body, clarify existing leave policies, delete the payment for unused leave so as to encourage residents to take adequate leave during their training, and provide first-year residents with the same amount of annual leave as more senior residents. Rule 6C1-5.0762 is being repealed and the substance of the rule will be encompassed in general rule on faculty evaluations, Rule 6C1-7.010, F.A.C. Rule 6C1-5.077 is being repealed as outdated and unnecessary to be included in state regulations. Rule 6C1-5.081 is being repealed as unnecessary to be included in state regulations.

**SUMMARY:** Rule 6C1-5.001 is being repealed because it merely restates state law. Rule 6C1-5.071 is being repealed. Rule 6C1-5.0761 is being amended to revise the leave provisions for residents, clarifying policies, increasing leave for first year residents and deleting payment for unused annual leave. Rule 6C1-5.0762 is being repealed. Rule 6C1-5.077 is being repealed. Rule 6C1-5.081 is being repealed.
