NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

NAME OF AGENCY: University of Florida

RULE TITLE:

Student Affairs: University Married Student Housing; Requirement for Signed Agreement 6C1-4.032

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: Rule 6C1-4.032 is amended to clarify the terms and conditions of the Rental Agreement between the University and students living in University married student housing, including the requirements of security deposits and transient taxes, the restrictions on smoking, appliances and pets, and the penalties for late payment of rent and improper checkout.

SUMMARY: Rule 6C1-4.032 is amended to clarify terms and conditions of the Rental Agreement for students and families occupying University married student housing, to establish the requirement that occupants pay a security deposit prior to occupying University Housing; to state requirements regarding late payment fees and transient taxes; to state the prohibitions on smoking, certain appliances and certain animals in University housing; to state terms and conditions of release from Rental Agreements; to clarify the penalties for improper checkout; and to make editorial changes.
