PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The amendments to Rule 6C1-2.001 clarify existing policy regarding the definition of "campus" for the purposes of possession and use of firearms. Rule 6C1-2.004 is being amended for the purpose of defining priorities in the use of facilities, the rule is amended to clarify that student groups are generally registered rather than recognized by the University. Rule 6C1-2.016 is being amended to clarify the existing policy on securing approval for tents or temporary structures by Student Government or registered student groups. Rule 6C1-2.0161 is amended to allow the designee of the Director of Student Activities to approve the hanging or draping of banners on campus and to clarify that contracted vendors should consult with the Work Management Center of the Physical Plant Division prior to digging postholes. Rule 6C1-2.0162 is being amended to correct the reference "rollerblades" to "in line skates." J. Wayne Reitz Union is added to the list of examples of areas in which in line skates are not allowed.

SUMMARY: The term "campus" is defined in Rule 6C1-2.001 to include any land or property occupied by the University of Florida. Rule 6C1-2.004: "University groups and organizations" under the rule are defined as including officially registered student groups. Rule 6C1-2.016 is being amended to clarify the existing policy on securing approval for tents or temporary structures by Student Government or registered student groups. The Director of Student Activities or the director's designee has authority to approve the banner permit application under Rule 6C1-2.0161. After approval, organizations or contracted vendors must consult with the Work Management Center of the Physical Plant before digging postholes. The references to "rollerblades" in Rule 6C1-2.0162 is changed to "in line skates." J. Wayne Reitz Union is added to the list of examples of areas in which in line skates are not allowed.
