PURPOSE AND EFFECT: Rule 6C1-4.004 is being amended to recognize that some fraternities are governed by Multicultural Greek Council. Rule 6C1-4.007 is amended to include within the definition of student public directory information a student's participation in officially registered activities and to clarify that student records may be released as provided by law. Rule 6C1-4.013 is amended to recognize that some fraternities are governed by the Multicultural Greek Council, and to apply the tolling provisions for hearing student judicial cases to cases that occur during the fall semester. Rule 6C1-4.016 is being amended to incorporate the 2000-2001 edition of the University of Florida Division of Rules and Regulations, which contains new policies that prohibit smoking, displaying objects in residence hall room windows, and sharing copyrighted material over the Division of Housing's computer network, and which clarifies existing policies on visitation and the use of electrical equipment. Rule 6C1-4.026 is amended to reflect that student disciplinary records will be maintained in the Dean of Students Office, and to provide for the requested destruction of a student disciplinary record involving a violation that resulted in only a written reprimand.
