PURPOSE AND EFFECT: 6C1-1.012: This rule refers to new pay plan designations of Academic Personnel and Technical, Executive, Administrative, and Managerial Support (TEAMS). The tuition-free program funded by the Florida Legislature is deleted. Changes have been made to the Certificate of Participation program. Procedures for the State of Florida employee tuition free program are set forth. **6C1-1.018:** The amendments to the rule refer to the new pay plan designations of Academic Personnel and Technical, Executive, Administrative, and Managerial Support (TEAMS). Clarifications in the Intellectual Property Policy reflect these changes and clarify the application of the Cultivar Royalty Policy.

SUMMARY: 6C1-1.012: The amendments refer to new pay plan designations of Academic Personnel and Technical, Executive, Administrative, and Managerial Support (TEAMS). New Certificates of Participation granted to persons who supervise student interns may be used at the University of Florida and not at all state universities. State employees are required to complete a form and secure approvals in order to participate in the state employee fee waiver program. The tuition free program funded by the Florida Legislature is deleted. **6C1-1.018:** The amendments to the rule refer to the new pay plan designations of Academic Personnel and Technical, Executive, Administrative, and Managerial Support (TEAMS). Clarifications in the Intellectual Property Policy reflect these changes and clarify the application of the Cultivar Royalty Policy.
