PURPOSE AND EFFECT: 6C1-3.037: The provision allowing waiver of tuition for Florida residents 60 years of age or over has been moved from a Board of Regents rule to this rule. **6C1-3.0374:** The amendments to the rule reflect the new governance structure for the University of Florida and remove the limit on the materials and supply fee. **6C1-3.0376:** The rule sets forth fees authorized by law and previously covered in Board of Regents rules. **6C1-3.048:** This rule is being repealed.

SUMMARY: 6C1-3.037: The provision allowing waiver of tuition for Florida residents 60 years of age or over auditing courses on a space available basis has been moved from a Board of Regents rule to this rule. 6C1-3.0374: The maximum for the materials and supply fee has been removed. 6C1-3.0376: The rules sets forth fees such as the application fee (\$30), library overdue fees, orientation fee (\$35), admissions deposit for the College of Dentistry (\$200), transcript and diploma fees, housing rental rates (variable), miscellaneous health related charges (cost), damaged, broken, and lost materials and equipment fees (cost). Registration for zero hours incurs a fee equal to that charged for one hour. Auditing fees are the same as those charged for tuition. The President is authorized to set additional fees for certain off-campus offerings. 6C1-3.048: This rule is being repealed.
