

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.006 clarify that the University assumes no liability for damage to vehicles operated or parked on campus and that any such damage is a risk assumed by the owner or operator of the motor vehicle. In Rule 6C1-3.007, the costs of parking decals for the University of Florida faculty, staff, students and commercial visitors have been increased. A separate category of decals for reserved parking for medical residents has been established. Weekly parking permits for those requiring short term parking are allowed. Rule 6C1-3.009 is being amended to state that the use of the City of Gainesville Regional Transit System is free to all students and staff with a valid Gator 1 identification card and to add a \$2 transportation access fee per credit hour on all courses and fundable credit hours taken by individuals at the University of Florida. Dental, medical and veterinary students must pay a semi-annual fee of \$40. Rule 6C1-3.014 is amended to increase the amount of the fine for false registration and the use of unauthorized duplicate or lost or stolen decals to include the cost of the equivalent parking decal. Rule 6C1-3.030 is amended to incorporate the current Report of Survey form. The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.0372 indicate the new student health, athletic, and activity fees for the 2001-2002 academic year. The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.0374 increase the maximum amount that can be charged for material and supply fees. Rule 6C1-3.040 is amended to increase the division level award from \$100 to \$200 and to include Division 2 in the Division 1 category. The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.048 eliminate the provision that prohibits the employment of minors. Rule 6C1-3.050 adds clarifying language that probationary appraisals are required prior to the conclusion of the probationary period and documenting existing University practice related to the removal of an employee from a class. Rule 6C1-3.059 is amended to require 6 months of satisfactory employee performance after disciplinary action before eligibility for promotional opportunities.

**SUMMARY:** Rule 6C1-3.006 clarifies that the University assumes no liability for damage to vehicles operated or parked on campus and that any such damage is a risk assumed by the owner

or operator of the motor vehicle. Rule 6C1-3.007 amends the costs of parking decals for University of Florida faculty, staff, and students which have been increased \$12-\$48 for an annual decal depending on the parking area and \$4-\$16 for a semester decal. The commercial decal is increased by \$18 for an annual decal and \$6 for a semester decal. A separate category for decals for reserved parking for medical residents has been established with an annual fee of \$258 and a semester fee of \$86. Monthly and weekly parking permits may be sold for those requiring short term parking. The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.009 state that the use of the City of Gainesville Regional Transit System is free to all students and staff with a valid Gator 1 identification card and add a \$2 transportation access fee per credit hour on all courses and fundable credit hours taken by individuals at the University of Florida. Dental, medical and veterinary students must pay a semi-annual fee of \$40. 6C1-3.014 increases the amount of parking fines for false registration and the use of unauthorized duplicate or lost or stolen decals to include the cost of the equivalent parking decal. Rule 6C1-3.030 is amended to incorporate the current version of the Report of Survey form. Rule 6C1-3.0372 is being amended to reflect the fee increase for student health, athletic, and activity fees submitted by the University to the Board of Regents pursuant to the provisions of Section 250.235(1) of the Florida Statutes and approved by the Board. Rule 6C1-3.0374 is being amended to increase the maximum amount that can be charged for material and supply fees by the University as approved by the President to \$45 per course. Rule 6C1-3.042 is being amended to change the amount the division level awards may not exceed from \$100 to \$200 and to include the Division 2 in the Division 1 category which would eliminate the Division 2 category. Rule 6C1-3.048 is being amended to delete the minimum age reference for employment to ensure consistency with appropriate child labor laws. Rule 6C1-3.050 clarifies that a probationary appraisal is required prior to the conclusion of the probationary period, that an employee will not receive a probationary appraisal if they are removed from the current class as a result of a change in assignment. The amendments to Rule 6C1-3.059 require 6 months of satisfactory employee performance after disciplinary action before eligibility for promotional opportunities.
