PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The changes to Rule 6C1-4.006 update the procedures for student groups that wish to see new merchandise or collect funds on campus. Permits are valid only for the specific event. Rule 6C1-4.037: To provide students participating in programs and activities involving foreign travel with written notice of the risks of foreign travel.

SUMMARY: Permits are valid only for the specific event in Rule 6C1-4.006. Rule 6C1-4.037: The University shall provide to students participating in programs and activities involving foreign travel a written notice of the risks associated with foreign travel.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COST: No statement of estimated regulatory costs has been prepared. Any person who wishes to provide information regarding the statement of estimated regulatory costs, or to provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.
