6C1-4.004 Student Affairs: Social Fraternities and Sororities.

(1) Social fraternities and sororities exist at the University of Florida as residential units or groups under policies established by the Dean of Students Office. Effective August 1, 1985, fraternities and sororities that provide housing for fifteen (15) or more students must have a live-in resident advisor in accordance with criteria set forth by the Dean of Students Office. The criteria are set forth in "Fraternity and Sorority House Director Policy," 8/13/99, incorporated herein by reference.

(2) Sororities and Fraternities are governed by the Panhellenic Council, Interfraternity Council, Multicultural Greek Council, or the National Panhellenic Council. The policies, governing constitutions, by-laws, rules and regulations of these Councils must not conflict with the rules of the Board of Regents and the University of Florida or University policies, including but not limited to, the policies established by the Dean of Students Office, which are the "Fraternity and Sorority House Director Policy" and the "Alcohol and Social Functions Policy," rev. 1992, which is incorporated herein by reference and can be obtained from the Dean of Students Office. Refer also to 6C1-4.003(1), F.A.C.

(3) The right of a fraternity or a sorority to exist at the University can be revoked by the University if a fraternity or sorority fails to comply with the rules and regulations of the

University or the Board of Regents or University policies, including but not limited to, the policies established by the Dean of Students Office as noted above.
