PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The amendments indicate the student health, athletic, and activity and service fees for University of Florida students enrolled in a New World School for the Arts degree program in Miami.

SUMMARY: The student health, athletic, and activity and service fees for University of Florida students enrolled in a New World School of the Arts program are per credit hour: health fee, \$7.32; athletic fee, zero; and activity and service fee, \$10.68.
