**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To clarify that faculty members assigned to deliver clinical care are responsible for obtaining clinical privileges at facilities where they practice and for maintaining unrestricted privileges at those facilities.

**SUMMARY:** The rule is clarified to make explicit the requirement that faculty members must obtain clinical privileges at facilities where they practice and must then maintain the privileges without restriction.
