

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

NAME OF AGENCY: University of Florida

RULE TITLE:

University of Florida College of Medicine; Duty to Maintain Clinical Privileges

RULE NO.:

6C1-5.0763

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: To clarify that faculty members assigned to deliver clinical care are responsible for obtaining clinical privileges at facilities where they practice and for maintaining unrestricted privileges at those facilities.

SUMMARY: The rule is clarified to make explicit the requirement that faculty members must obtain clinical privileges at facilities where they practice and must then maintain the privileges without restriction.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COST: No statement of estimated regulatory costs has been prepared. Any person who wishes to provide information regarding the statement of estimated regulatory costs, or to provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.
