**NAME OF AGENCY:** University of Florida

**RULE TITLE:**  
Finance and Administration; Tuition Cost

**RULE NO.:**

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** To set the tuition for University of Florida students effective fall 2004.

**SUMMARY:** The rule increases the non-resident tuition for undergraduate, graduate, law, and dental students. The rule also increases the non-resident financial aid fee for undergraduate, graduate, law, and dental students.

**SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COST:** No statement of estimated regulatory costs has been prepared. Any person who wishes to provide information regarding the statement of estimated regulatory costs, or to provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.
