

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

**PURPOSE AND EFFECT:** **6C1-4.004:** The rule is being amended to incorporate the latest version of the Fraternity and Sorority Social Events Guidelines. **6C1-4.007:** The amendment expands the categories of publicly available information about students. **6C1-4.016:** The amendments update sanctions and procedures applicable in student conduct cases. **6C1-4.017:** The amendment modifies the definition of two conduct violations, “plagiarism” and “misrepresentation.” **6C1-4.020:** The rule is being amended to incorporate the latest version of the Student Honor Court Rules of Procedure. **6C1-4.0211:** The amendment changes certain requirements related to committee membership and procedures. **6C1-4.029:** The amendment expands application of assignment priorities to all students and broadens the categories of housing for which students may apply. **6C1-4.031:** The rule is being amended to update the residence hall agreement forms. **6C1-4.032:** The rule is being amended to incorporate the latest versions of the Single Graduate Apartment Housing and Family Housing Apartment Registration Certificates.

**SUMMARY:** **6C1-4.004:** The rule establishes new facilities, identifications, and security requirements for social events listed by UF fraternities and sororities. **6C1-4.007:** The amendment adds “enrollment status” to the list of public information about students. **6C1-4.016:** The amendments update the definitions of conduct probation and increases the University’s authority to hold hearings when an accused student no-shows without proper advanced notice. **6C1-4.017:** The amendment expands plagiarism violations to include both “attempts” and “acts” and removes the requirement of “intent” in order to commit misrepresentation. **6C1-4.020:** The rule is being amended to incorporate the latest version of the Student Honor Court Rules of Procedure revised November 2000. **6C1-4.0211:** The amendment reduces the faculty membership on the committee from five to four and reduces the required term of service for both faculty and student members. The amendment also designates the Director of Student Judicial Affairs to serve as a non-voting coordinator. The amendments also reduce the number of committee members required to hear a case and sets a standard for quorum. **6C1-4.029:** The amendment expands application of assignment priorities to all students and broadens the

categories of housing for which students may apply. **6C1-4.031:** The rule is being amended to update the University's residence hall agreement forms. **6C1-4.032:** The rule is being amended to incorporate the latest versions of the Single Graduate Apartment Housing and Family Housing Apartment Registration Certificates.
