6C1-6.016 IFAS; Visitation to or Use of Certain Facilities.

~~— (1) Except in unusual circumstances or in specifically defined areas, the Austin Cary Forest near Waldo, Florida, and the Anhinga Roost Island Preserve near Windsor, Florida, are not available for recreational or other uses by the general public.~~

~~— (2) Members of the public wishing to visit the Horticultural Unit located in Gainesville may do so provided they obtain permission in advance from a faculty member associated with the Unit and that when visiting the Unit they are accompanied by a faculty member.~~

(13) Visitation to the Research and Education Centers or other IFAS managed properties in Florida:

(a) Members of the public wishing to tour the Research and Education facilities~~Centers~~ may do so provided they obtain permission in advance from a faculty member associated with the facilities~~Center~~ and that when touring the facilities ~~of the Center~~ they are accompanied by an IFAS~~Center~~ employee.

(b) Minor children, singly or in groups, when visiting the research centers, departments, or other IFAS research and education sites must be accompanied by parents or a responsible adult at all times.

(2) Use of IFAS facilities by outside groups is restricted to organizations that have direct research, extension or teaching programmatic relationships with IFAS. The University will charge maintenance or minor use fees to cover direct costs incurred from proposed uses.
